# Taos Ski Valley, New Mexico

Taos Ski Valley, high in the Sangre de Cristo Mountains a short drive from Taos, has been legendary among hard-core ski enthusiasts since its inception. The northern exposure of the slopes make it a natural "powder pocket" unique in the high desert of New Mexico.

Founder, Ernie Blake recognized the unusual opportunity provided by the location, terrain, and orientation of the valley as he flew his single engine plane over the Northern New Mexico Mountains in the early 1950's. The Blake family moved into an eleven foot trailer at the base of the mountain and began to build. Little did they know that fifty years later Taos Ski Valley would be a world class ski resort! Today it remains one of the few family owned ski areas in North America.

Though relatively small (1,294 acres of ski terrain) it is New Mexico's biggest resort. Historically known for its expert slopes and deep powder, over the years TSV has developed intermediate terrain to rival any area. Also, due to its excellent ski school, it is a perfect place for beginners to get started and improve their skiing.

Taos Ski Valley was one of the last hold outs as a "skier only" mountain. However, beginning March 19, 2008 snowboarders will be welcome to share the coveted experience skiers have kept to themselves. Taos has always been a family oriented resort and the fact is, most skiing families today have members who prefer to snowboard!

Taos is one of the world's most unique and picturesque ski resorts. It is a place where one can escape into the ancient cultures of the Southwest or explore the side of a vast mountain that has been opened up for skiing but not tamed. Taos combines the warm ambiance of a small European-style village nestled at the base of a great mountain, a superb ski school and an ambiance founded on the classic pleasures of alpine skiing.

## **Edelweiss Lodge and Spa, 4 star**

The Edelweiss Lodge and Spa is truly the peak of luxury in the Taos Ski Valley. Located on the Strawberry Hill slopes and in the main base area village, the Edelweiss features true ski-in/ski-out convenience. The Edelweiss Lodge & Spa blends a sophisticated ambience, an array of amenities, and professional service for a first-class lodging.

The Edelweiss Lodge & Spa offers one, two, and three bedroom condominiums as well a limited number of "lock-off hotel rooms". Each condominium is uniquely furnished and has a fully equipped kitchen, living room, dining area, washer/dryer, gas fireplace, satellite television, and high speed internet. Property amenities include boot lockers, complimentary ski valet service, on-site underground parking, an exercise facility, dry sauna, and outdoor hot tub.

The Edelweiss Spa offers a range of spa treatments including a variety of massage therapies, facials, body scrubs, and private yoga instruction. Also on-site, The Blonde Bear Tavern has a bar, lounge area, and dining room for Après Ski bites and drinks as well as a full dinner menu presented by Chef Joseph Wrede. The lobby game room has a television, pool table and foosball to keep the kids entertained. Café Naranja is open daily through the winter for breakfast and lunch as well as offering an assortment of snacks, drinks and package beer, wine and liquor.
